DIRECTED MEETING OF THE NEW RIVER PRESBYTERY

The New River Presbytery met in accordance to the direction of the General Assembly ^{for the purpose of acting on the request to transfer the counties of Clark, Warren, & Frederick to Mid Atlantic Presbytery.} on Wednesday, June 10th at 1:15 p.m. behind the stage of the gymnasium at Calvin College in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

The Rev. Mike Hall opened the meeting with prayer.
