

MINUTES OF MEETING OF NEW RIVER PRESBYTERY HELD AT
JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI ON SEPTEMBER 11, 1975

A called meeting of New River Presbytery was held at 8:15 AM during the meeting of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in America on September 11, 1975 at Jackson, Mississippi. The meeting was opened with prayer after which Mr. Summers Dunbar, moderator, declared that a quorum was present. Oliver G. Blake was elected clerk for the meeting.

The following resolution by Rev. David Williams was duly seconded and passed:

"Be it resolved that New River Presbytery request the Mission to the United States to assist the Covenant Presbyterian of St. Albans in the purchase of property commensurate to the immediate need of \$10,000.00. The Presbytery expresses its appreciation to Larry Mills, Coordinator, for his help and vision in bringing the Covenant Church to its present location and mission."

Mr. Larry Mills, Coordinator of the Mission to the United States, met briefly with Presbytery and indicated that his committee would probably grant a loan of \$5,000.00 to the Covenant Church. After a season of prayer for the Covenant Church, the meeting was adjourned with prayer at 9:00 AM.

Presbytery reconvened at 5:00 PM and a quorum being present, was opened with prayer. It was voted unanimously not to change the fall meeting of Presbytery scheduled to be held at the Lebanon Church, Craigsville, Va. on November 14 & 15, 1975. The meeting was closed with prayer at 5:25 PM.
